<b>Number of Awards</b>	TWO (ONE for a student enrolled in <b><i>School of Science Computing and Artificial Intelligence</i></b> and ONE open to students from <b>ANY School</b> ).
<b>Value</b>	EC\$5000.00 (each)
<b>Requirements</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Complete the UWI FIC Financial Awards Application Form</li><li>Demonstrate a commitment to give back to society by submitting TWO community service references</li><li>Participate in a scholarship interview</li><li>Demonstrate financial need</li></ol>
<b>Application Deadline</b>	<b>January 5, 2024</b>
<b>Method of Selection</b>	The scholarship will be advertised on the Campus website and/or any other media.  Short-listed candidates will be further evaluated by interview with the selection committee.
